(QUESTION 1 (ONE) ATTRACTS 25 MARKS)

1. In 2011, the defendant Mazi Ibe who was a rice farm owner engaged in dependent contractor to build a reservoir on his land to supply water to his rice farm. During construction, the contractors found disused mine shafts and passages which unknown to them linked the plaintiff's mines on the adjoining land.

The contractors carelessly omitted to block the disused shaft and when the reservoir was filled with water, it escaped and flooded the plaintiff's mine inflicting damage. With the 2017 recession still in place, the plaintiff's son who just graduated from the law school convinced the plaintiff for legal actions to be commenced against the defendant. "Equity aids the vigilant and not the indolent", Discuss this assertion and indicate if there are any limitations to this maxim.

- 2. No one who has witnessed the rigidity of the common law rules should have sympathy for it whenever equitable maxims are used to exclude the application of common rules in certain cases. In your understanding of the relationship between equity and common law, do you think this is a correct view?
