[CSS843] Guerrilla warfare is often associated with Rural setting.

[CSS843] A military commander designs to identify conditions in the operational environment that have changed or that are not well understood.
Refraining indicator

[CSS843] Although the use of special operation forces seems like a recent military novelty, armies have used such forces in military operations since 249 BC

[CSS843] Objectives, end state and line of operations are that help joint force commanders and staff visualize, describe and modify a joint operation framework.
Operational design elements

[CSS843] The classical Maoist model of guerrilla warfare is in Three (3) phases.

[CSS843] Where there are numerous competing guerrilla groups in one theatre, the best counter-guerrilla approach is to Control the overall environment rather than defeat a specific enemy

[CSS843] A red team is a group of soldiers that help the intelligence staff gather information that boosts understanding of the operational environment's tensions, potentials and tendencies.

[CSS843] Combat assessment comprises all but one of these elements.
