[CSS843] In military theory, the source of power that provides moral or physical strength, freedom of action or will to act is called Centre of gravity

[CSS843] After the World War I, B. L. Liddell Hart popularized the concept of Indirect approach, which generally entails the avoidance of enemy strength.
