[NSC301] ____ enable a person to report self-experiences of health on a day-to-day basis.
Symptoms

[NSC301] ____ refers to the way in which symptoms are perceived, evaluated and acted upon by a person who recognizes such pain, discomfort or other signs of organic malfunctioning
Illness behaviour

[NSC301] For the psychologist, ____ involves the development of interventions to help people practice good health habits and change poor ones
Health Promotion

[NSC301] ____ was developed to explain and predict behaviour in health context
The Health Belief Model

[NSC301] Patient/ doctor relationship are sometimes unequal and requires higher levels of trust.
Vulnerability

[NSC301] ____ is by definition a self-limiting disease which is mostly characterized by the symptoms having a rapid onset.
