[EDU721] Teachers may provide positive reinforcement by smiling or nodding at students after a correct response

[EDU721] Transfer of learning is said to be positive  
When something previously learned benefits performance or learning in a new situation

[EDU721] According to Maslow  
Basic needs must be satisfied before higher needs are fulfilled

[EDU721] We are motivated extrinsically when  
We do something in order to obtain some reward or avoid some sanctions

[EDU721] The basic needs that must be satisfied for survival are known as  
physiological needs

[EDU721] What branch of Psychology is interested in the ways in which the behaviour  
of one affects others?  
Social psychology

[EDU721] Failure to retain what has been acquired or learnt is known as  
forgetting

[EDU721] When the acquisition of new learning works backward to impair the retention  
of the previously learnt material, it is called  
retroactive inhibition

[EDU721] The role that reinforcement serves in social learning theory is that it  
increases the chance that what has been learnt will definitely be performed
