In fact, we sold large quantities of the Solution in Kogi State as preventive against this disease and there is no advertised case where the disease has progressed by those using the Solution. One bottle of the Solution will last a family for one week, making it a cheap remedy at the price of ₦1,250.00 per bottle. The Solution can be bought at the address stated below.
