QUESTION 5

As a Project Finance Analyst, you have been called upon by the Project Director to provide an analysis and give professional advice on the suitability of choosing between two projects. The details of the projects are shown below.

Our company must choose between two investments, Project A and Project B. It cannot undertake both investments. The expected cash flows for each project are:

The company has a policy that the maximum permissible payback period for an investment is three years and if a choice has to be made between two projects, the project with the earlier payback will be chosen.

- (i) assuming that cash flows occur at that year end
